



## Belinda Hollingsworth

February 23, 1933 - May 1, 2026

Belinda Thomas Hollingsworth, 93, of High Springs, Florida, passed away peacefully on May 1, 2026, surrounded by those who loved her.

Belinda lived a life defined by leadership, service, and a deep investment in people. She was a mentor to many, a steady presence in her community, and someone whose kindness and influence touched countless lives. She had a natural ability to connect with others—offering guidance, encouragement, and, when needed, clear direction. She was always “in charge” in the best way, with a confidence and care that people trusted and appreciated.

She had a lifelong love for her family, her work, the beach, and the art of presentation. Known for her keen eye and sense of aesthetics, Belinda became a trusted source of advice in fashion and style. She built a remarkable career in retail, owning and working in multiple clothing stores throughout her life, serving everyone from babies to men and women.

Belinda spent the majority of her career managing Ammalee’s Dress Shop in High Springs, at the time the longest-running women’s clothing store in the state of Florida. Customers traveled from across the state not just for the clothing, but for her insight, honesty, and expertise.

She never truly retired. After Amalee’s closed, Belinda brought new life to the

Haven Hospice Thrift Store, transforming it into a space that rivaled a luxury department store. At the age of 83, she continued her work at Bealls Outlet, later dedicating herself as a caregiver for her sister-in-law, and remained deeply invested in her family and loved ones through her final days—living alone and maintaining her independence until the very end, just as she had always lived—on her own terms.

Belinda was one of ten siblings and maintained strong, lifelong connections with her family. She was often a guiding presence and a mother figure to many of her nieces and nephews. Above all, she was a devoted mother, grandmother, and great-grandmother who loved her family deeply.

A dedicated member of First Baptist Church of High Springs since childhood, Belinda was baptized, married, and remained rooted in her faith and church community throughout her life.

She is survived by her children, Randy “Gator” Hollingsworth, Vicki Swick (Tibbs), and Jacob Hollingsworth; her grandchildren, Tibbs Swick Jr. (Amanda) and Amanda Olmert (Gannon); her sister, Kate Davis; six great-grandsons whom she loved dearly; and many nieces and nephews.

She was preceded in death by her parents, Clifton L. “C.L.” Thomas and Minnie Estelle Thomas; her husband, Johnny Hollingsworth; her siblings, Gladys Thomas, Berta Moore, Lonnis Crews, Glenn R. “Turk” Thomas, William E. “Karo” Thomas, L.C. Thomas, Donald Thomas, and Barbara Ann Bryan; and beloved nieces and nephews.

Belinda’s legacy is one of strength, generosity, and lasting impact. She leaves behind a family and community better because she was part of it.

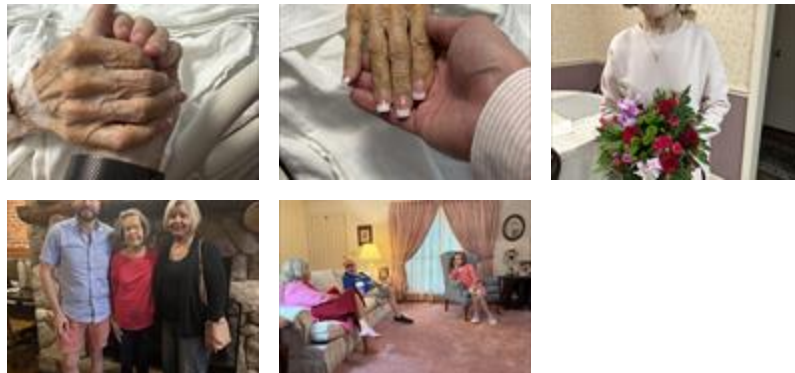
