Bobby "Bob" Charles Davis, 86, of Old Town, Florida passed away August 17, 2023.

Mr. Davis was born March 8, 1937 to the late Charlie and Myrtle Davis in Kennett, Missouri, but had lived in the Dixie County area since 1972, after moving here from Safety Harbor, Florida.
