Eva Lois Fontenot, 92, of Bell, Florida passed away May 10, 2022.

Mrs. Fontenot was born November 3, 1929 to the late Wilton and Della Sauls in Fletcher, Florida, but had lived in the Bell area since 1980, after moving there from Virginia Beach, Virginia. She had been a military house wife for 23 years and in her early life she was an instructor in vocational cosmetology. Mrs. Fontenot had been a pole worker at Cruse Voting Center in Gilchrist County for several years, had volunteered with Haven Hospice for 10 years, had volunteered with The Red Cross, and was a member of Mt. Nebo Baptist Church. She was a life member with the V.F.W., had been a Senior Regent in 1994 with the Suwannee River Moose Lodge No. 325 in Fanning Springs, and was a member of the AMVETS Ladies Auxiliary. Mrs. Fontenot had several other accomplishments, and will always be remembered as a woman of integrity.

Mrs. Fontenot is survived by her sons Robert Smith (Hallie), William Fontenot (Sally), Weldon Fontenot (Shirley), Joe Fontenot, and Wallace Fontenot (Lorrie), 9 grandchildren, 21 great-grandchildren, 6 great-great-grandchildren, and other extended family members. She was preceded in death by her husband Warren Fontenot.
