FRANK HALL, 97, of Cross City passed away July 29, 2017.

Pastor Hall was born October 24, 1919 to the late Robert and Annie Hall in Omar, West Virginia, but had lived in Cross City for the last 47 years of his life when not away serving Churches. He was a Veteran of the United States Army serving towards the end of World War II, and was most recently a Pastor at The Lord Jesus Christ Church in Yellowbad, Ohio where he served for over 30 years.

Pastor Hall is survived by his son Kenny Hall (Linda), his step sons Davey Forehand (Ruth), Danny Forehand (Carol Anne), his step daughters Julie Sherill (Mark) and Jenny Brown (Charlie), a host of grandchildren and great-grandchildren, and other extended family members. He was preceded in death by his first wife Roxie Hall, his second wife Joanelle Hall, and a daughter Kathleen Jeffers.

Funeral services for Pastor Hall will be held 3:00 PM Friday, August 4, 2017 in the Rick Gooding Funeral Home Cross City Chapel, with Reverend Richard McKinney officiating.
