



## Hogan S. Green

September 9, 1921 - July 26, 2022

Hogan Shelby Green, 100, of Old Town, Florida passed away July 26, 2022.

Mr. Green was born September 9, 1921 to the late Shelby and Effie Green in Bernie, Missouri, but had lived in the Old Town area for 45 years after moving here from Michigan. He was a World War II Veteran of the United States Army, retired from General Motors in Flint, MI, and was a member of McCrabb Baptist Church.
