Jeremy "Dixie" Eugene Davis of Old Town, Florida went home to Jesus on July 9th 2022 at age 39 after a 3-year battle of brain cancer. Jeremy was born to Eugene and Susan Davis on July 14, 1982, in Gainesville FL. Jeremy graduated Dixie County High School in 2000 and volunteered with the Dixie County Fire Rescue for 2 years. Jeremy attended Lake City community college where he earned his AA degree.

Jeremy was a very proud veteran, serving in the United States Air Force 2002 -2006 where he earned his A.S Degree in Electronic Systems Technology. He went on to begin his career in telecommunications with AT&T for a few years and then dedicated himself to the Department of Corrections as a correctional officer sergeant for 10 years. Throughout his entire life, he held an unwavering faith in Jesus Christ.

Jeremy met his wife, Stephanie (Trotter) Davis in 2015 while both working within the Florida Department of Corrections. They married on May 12th, 2018. 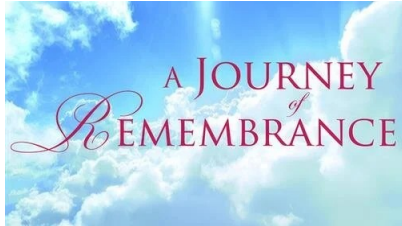

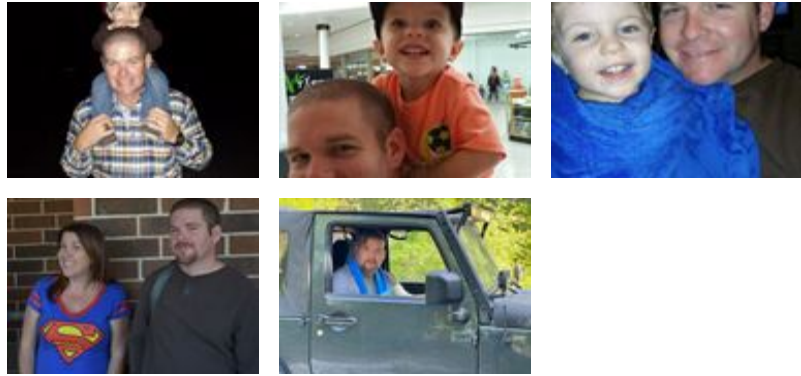
