Jerry Wayne Meeks, 71, of Chiefland, Florida passed away May 21, 2020.

Mr. Meeks was born August 12, 1948 to the late John and Bessie Meeks in Ellzey, Florida. He was a Veteran of the United States Army and received a Purple Heart during the Vietnam War.
