JORDON RUSSELL WARD, 25, of Cross City passed away June 16, 2017.

Jordon was born February 28, 1992 in Sioux Falls, South Dakota, but had lived in the Dixie County area since 2006. He had worked as a Firefighter / EMT with Levy County, Dixie County, Gilchrist County, Cross City Correctional, and Shands Care. Jordon served in the United States Marine Corps Reserve, was a member of the Dixie County Dive Rescue Team, and had been a member of the Cross City Volunteer Fire Department. He attended Lydia Baptist Church in Cross City.
