MARTY MURPHY, 73, of Steinhatchee passed away October 18, 2016.

Mr. Murphy was born in St. Louis, Missouri September 26, 1943 to the late John and Helen Murphy. Mr. Murphy worked for several years in the construction business and was a member of the I.U.O.E. Local 513 in St. Louis, he was also a Veteran of the United States Navy having served during the Cuban Missile Crisis. Mr. Murphy was a member of The American Legion Post 291 in Steinhatchee, Suwannee River AMVETS Post 422 in Fanning Springs, and the VFW Post 4254 in Bonita Springs, Florida. He had lived in Steinhatchee since 2011 after moving here from Bonita Springs.
