Penny Sue Williams, 66, of Old Town, Florida passed away on April 15, 2021. She was born August 28, 1954 in Stroudsburg, Pennsylvania.

She was a member of McCall's Chapel United Methodist Church for several years. She was a Veteran of the United States Army Reserve. During her enlistment she took part in a pilot program whereby soldiers were put on active duty and sent to civilian schools to increase their military occupational specialty. She graduated in the top 25% of her class and passed her state board to become a licensed practical nurse with a 96 percentile. She formerly worked as a Pediatric Home Care Nurse and loved her job very much. She also graduated from East Stroudsburg University with a Bachelor of Science in psychology, with minors in sociology, and women's studies. She was ardently pro-woman and marched on Washington DC, Harrisburg, PA, and the courthouse square in Stroudsburg. She was a 1972 graduate from Stroudsburg High School.

She is survived by her father, Norman Williams of Lady Lake, Florida; her daughter, Dominique "Nikki" Ariel Metzgar of Aguilar, Colorado; her grandson, Keyton Wesley Metzgar; her granddaughters, Autumn SueAnn Schroth, Paetin Izabel Schroth, and Shevylin Skye Alvord; her many friends and family of McCall's Chapel; and her "boys" Chai and Loki. She was preceded in death by her mother Bertha Getz Hagerty and her "2nd" mom Eleanor Williams.
