Robert "Bob" H. Pollard, 89, of Old Town, Florida passed away August 7, 2019.

Mr. Pollard was born October 17, 1929 to the late Ralph and Gertrude Pollard in St. Louis, MO, but had lived in the Old Town area since 1989 after moving from Illinois. During his life, he had served in the United States Air Force in the Korean War, worked with the Tazewell County Sheriff's Office in Illinois as a Deputy and Detective, and he had owned a gas station in Illinois. Mr. Pollard was of the Catholic Faith.

Mr. Pollard is survived by his daughter Lisa Corbin (Rodney), his brother Tom Pollard (Maureen), eight grandchildren, eight great-grandchildren, and other extended family members. He was preceded in death by his wife Dena Pollard, his sons Danny Pollard and Mark Pollard, and eight siblings.
