Born on September 5, 2008, in Gainesville, Florida and raised in Chiefland, Florida. Tiny was the daughter of Lance and Dana Langford. She was a Junior at Dixie County High School after a recent transfer from Chiefland, where she attended school through the 9th grade. When she transferred, it did not take long for Tiny to build new unbreakable bonds, however her friendships remained steadfast with those she grew up with in Chiefland. Tiny was a member of Concord Baptist Church of Chiefland, where Brother Jamie Brock Baptized her. She gave her heart to Jesus at First Baptist Church of Chiefland Vacation Bible School, where Brother Gordon Keller led her to Christ. Tiny was active in the FFA, she showed Cows in the Suwannee River Fair and was the maker of the Prize-Winning Pickles in the Home Economics division. She was a member of journalism and the BETA club.
