Joel Stanton “Stant” Bradley, 58, of Old Town, Florida passed away November 23, 2023. He was born October 3, 1965 in Gainesville, Florida, but had been a lifelong resident of Old Town.

Mr. Bradley retired as a Major from the Dixie County Sheriff’s Office, then retired as the Chief of Police from the Cross City Police Department, and in his younger years helped his father with his construction company. 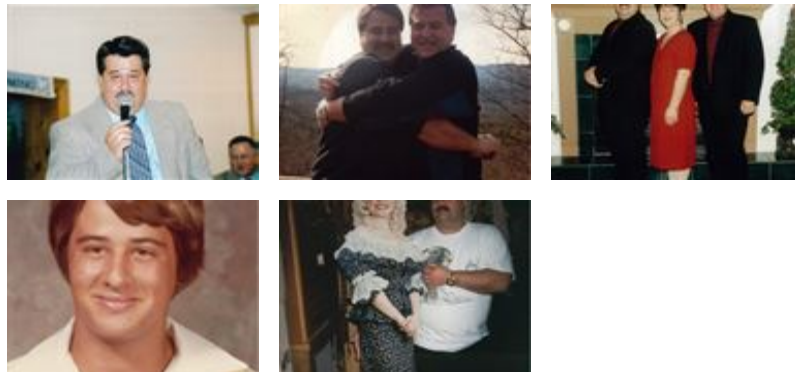
